Developmental Disabilities Administration Provider Grants, Maryland Community Health Resource Commission

\$5.0 Million (M00R01.03)

Purpose: Recovery Now Funding

The Commission shall provide grants to community providers of services under Title 7 of the Health – General Article, concerning services provided to individuals served by the Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA), to support pandemic-related reopening, transformation, and revenue loss.

June 30 - Program Highlights and Plans to Allocate Remaining Balance:

- The CHRC issued a non-competitive RFP on Thursday, April 15, 2021, to distribute the \$5M made available for DDA providers under the Relief Act. At the June 4 meeting, the CHRC Commissioners voted to approve 117 awards totaling \$3,307,647. The CHRC extended the submission deadline for additional providers to apply and received 44 applications requesting \$847,900. Of initial 117 awards, eight awards have been adjusted for a revised total of \$3,289,147 and these modest adjustments were approved by the CHRC Commissioners at the CHRC's meeting on June 24. Also, at the June 24 meeting, the CHRC Commissioners approved the second round of awards, for 44 applicants totaling \$847,900, and supplemental awards for 160 grantees totaling \$868,250.
- The three figures quoted above total slightly more than the \$5 million appropriated for this purpose. The Commission plans to cover the overage with MCHRC funds.
