SUMMARY

The Baltimore City Community College is Maryland's only State-operated community college. It offers day, evening, and weekend courses at satellite locations around Baltimore City, as well as at its two primary locations: the Harbor Campus located near the Inner Harbor, and the Liberty Campus in northwest Baltimore. The College's mission is to provide high quality transfer, technical, and career programs; continuing education and developmental education courses; and community service programs, at low cost to students. These programs enable students to continue their education at upper division educational institutions, and/or obtain the necessary skills for career success based on community needs and workplace requirements.

The primary focus of the College's FY 2005 - FY 2009 Capital Improvement Program is on the modernization of the Main Building on the Liberty Campus. This structure, built in 1965 to house most of the academic and administrative programs on campus, has become physically and functionally inadequate. The proposed improvements will provide modern instructional and administrative space, and improve the functionality of existing space. The FY 2005 - FY 2009 Capital Improvement Program also includes funds to renovate and expand the Bard Library on the Liberty Campus.

Additions:

Main Building Renovation - Liberty Campus (P,C): The renovation of the Fine Arts Wing (Phase II) has been put on hold at the 50% design development stage pending the College's re-evaluation of the project scope. The FY 2005 budget includes funding to advance construction of the Student Services Wing (Phase III) ahead of Phase II. Phase III consists of the renovation of the 56,000 GSF Student Services Wing and the construction of 10,100 GSF of new space.

Main Building Renovation - Liberty Campus FY 2005 Total \$14,675

Upgrade the College's signature building, constructed in 1965 on the Liberty Heights Avenue campus, to provide 265,000 GSF of modern academic and administrative space. The project is intended to enhance instructional space for new and existing programs and activities; to correct functional deficiencies and design inadequacies; to upgrade utility systems, including fire suppression, HVAC, electrical, and telecommunications; and to replace external curtain walls. The project will be constructed in three phases because it is impractical to close the entire building for renovation. The FY 2005 budget includes additional planning funds to complete the design of the Fine Arts Wing (Phase II) and the Student Services Wing (Phase III). Construction funds for the renovation of 56,000 GSF and the creation of 10,100 GSF of new space in the Student Services Wing (Phase III) are also provided.
